All people on earth have the same articulatory apparatus, but each language chooses certain positions of the speech organs to produce sounds. In English, like no other language, there are many words whose spelling is difficult to explain. The fact is that the writing of the Angles and Saxons, who conquered Britain, did not change with the same intensity as pronunciation during the transition from runes to the Latin alphabet. For this reason, many lexical units in English are pronounced differently from how they are written, and there are also words that are read differently in different contexts. For example, it is almost impossible for a beginner to read the word choir without the help of a native speaker, and the pronunciation of the verb read (in the past tense read) sounds different in different contexts. Transcription uses to convey in writing the reference sound of English vocabulary, and knowledge of it allows you to easily pronounce previously unfamiliar words correctly on your own. The need to master English transcription is also due to some discrepancies between the spelling and pronunciation of individual words that have either unreadable letters or exceptions to the rules. Transcription symbols - there are various classifications of English sounds based on the participation of the speech organs, the way air flows are obstructed, the place of pronunciation, and other articulation options. In total, modern linguists in the English language count 44 sounds, which correspond to certain transcription signs. Along with them, the following service symbols use in English transcription.

- 1. Square brackets denoting the transcription entry itself: pen [pen]
- 2. The colon symbol used to express the length of a sound: dark [da:k]
- 3. Parentheses in the event that a certain sound may be "dropped out": summer ['samə(r)]
- 4. There are two types of stress marks the upper one, similar to an apostrophe, and the lower one in the form of a stroke at the bottom before the syllable:
- 5. demonstration [demon'streisn]
- 6. Just like individual characters, transcribed words are enclosed in square brackets. According to the type of stress, transcriptions of words can be divided into three groups: monosyllabic, where there is no need to put an accent mark.



For ease of memorization, we will divide sounds into consonants, vowels and diphthongs (indivisible vowels consisting of two elements forming one syllable). It is not recommended to find complete correspondences of English sounds to transcription signs of the native language. Some of them are unique, others pronounce with significant differences, and some of them are very close in pronunciation to Uzbek sounds.

Features of English pronunciation

The organs of speech are structured the same in all peoples. However, each language has its own peculiarities in sound structure, its own ways of pronouncing sounds and phrases. Each language characterize by a certain structure of the speech organs and has its own characteristics in the intonation of the sentence. The same applies to English pronunciation.

Unlike the Russian language, voiced consonants in English at the end of words and before voiceless consonants are not devoiced. Voicedness and deafness in the English language are a semantic distinguishing feature that distinguishes one word from another: bad - bat.

In English, articulation, i.e. the pronunciation of vowels is almost unaffected by consonants. The vowel sound is the leading sound in articulation. In this regard, it recommends when setting up English pronunciation to combine as many different consonant sounds as possible with a vowel sound.

English, without exaggeration, is the most widely spoken foreign language in the world. It is also the official language of the UK, USA, Canada, Australia and New Zealand. Naturally, due to the geographical distance from classical English, the peculiarities of life and culture in the USA, Canada, Australia and New Zealand, their own pronunciation features appeared. Since American English is only a variant of the English language, it basically retains the sound base of the English language, while having some features.

Teaching like American English must be give attention for the pronunciation system.

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
