Quality Education, In the Example of Korakol Boarding School

Abstract: In this article, the history, material support of the 164th specialized lyceum, boarding school, Karakol district, Bukhara region, pedagogical activities of the winners of the republican and world olympiads of this school are covered based on scientific data.

History of the 164th region "Young Mathematicians and Physicists" special boarding school in Karakol for the 1993-1994 academic year accepts students in 8th grade. The boarding school accepts documents from talented students interested in mathematics and physics on the basis of an interview. Students whose documents have been accepted will take the (written) entrance exam in mathematics.

The admissions office is open from August 1 to August 20, every day from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Entrance exams will be held on August 21-22. Students admitted to study are provided with clothing, warmth, food and accommodation. Entrants to the boarding school must submit the following documents:

Application to the director, birth certificate (original copy), residence certificate, health certificate (Uform 086), 5th, 6th, 7th grades, 4 photos of 3*4 centimeters [1]. So, the admission processes provided quality education, and the boarding school had good material support. The presence of a boarding school means that there are many educated young people. Quality education can be seen in the example of a gifted boarding school.

Pupils will go to Romania, 6 young people from Uzbekistan will participate in the international Olympiad of gifted mathematics youth, which will be held in this country on July 10-12. 3 of them are students of Lyceum 164 in Karakol. It is not for nothing that Karakol youth who took part in the 3rd round regional Olympiad in mathematics won all classes and the regional team that will participate in the national competition was made up of only them.

They justified their trust by participating in the republican Olympiad held in Tashkent on March 24-30. Umirzok G'aniev, a student of the 11th grade, took 1st place in the competition held at the academic Lyceum named after Sirojiddinov and won the right to go to Romania.

Aziz Iskandarov, a student of the 11th grade of the lyceum, was awarded with a third degree diploma at the republican Olympiad in physics and won the right to be admitted to a higher educational institution without tests. At the moment, young mathematicians from Karakol are actively preparing to take pride of place in the World Olympiad [2].

It would not be wrong to say that the International School of Mathematics in Karakol is well known even outside our country. The 2019-2020 academic year was very successful for the school. All 48 students who graduated from the International School of Mathematics were recommended for higher education. Students of the school won 4 gold, 7 silver, 5 bronze medals at international Olympiads. Talented students such as Nafosat Jorabekova and Sevara Ostonova were awarded the state award named after Zulfiya, while talented young people such as Daniyor Ismailov and Anvarbek Rahmatov were awarded the state award "Brave Boy".

On January 8-12 of this year, the 17th International Jautikov Olympiad in the fields of mathematics, physics and informatics and information technologies was organized remotely in the city of Alma-Ata of the Republic of Kazakhstan. A total of 1006 participants from 146 teams from 21 countries took part in this Olympiad. 14 Uzbek students took part and won 1 gold, 2 silver and 11 bronze medals. The most gratifying thing is that 4 of the winners and runners-up are students from Karakol. The 6th International Caucasian Mathematical Olympiad, held on March 12-17, was also successful for students from Karakol. In particular, Olimjon Olimov won a silver medal, Daniyor Ismailov won a bronze medal. On July 14-24, at the International Olympiad organized by the Russian Federation, Olimjon Olimov won a bronze medal, and Daniyor Ismailov received an honorary diploma.

As a unique summary of the achievements, the teachers and students of the prestigious school got a new educational complex with all modern facilities. Within the framework of the investment program, more than 45 billion soums were spent, and the construction of the complex with all the important conditions of modern education was carried out by the builders of "Sharq Plus".

Although more than 10 years have passed since its operation, until now we did not have a private educational building, - says the director of this school, Temur Roziev, owner of the "Labor Glory" order. - According to the order of our president, a new school with 720 seats was built for us. All the conditions for studying are available here. Classrooms are equipped according to international standards. In addition to a 320-bed dormitory, the new building also has a library, a museum, a hall for activists and a 50-bed hotel.

In 2009, the institution, which operated in such forms as the 164th specialized lyceum, the 1st specialized boarding school in Karakol district, the 3rd academic lyceum under Bukhara State University, was established in 2009 in the form of "State specialized general education school with indepth study of certain subjects" No. 52. On September 1, 2014, by the order of the Bukhara regional administration, No. 1, under the management of the regional public education department, was transformed into a "specialized state general education boarding school with in-depth study of certain subjects". With the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 9, 2019 "On the establishment of the "International School of Mathematics" in the Karakol District of Bukhara Region", it was reorganized as the International School of Mathematics.

In the International School of Mathematics, students receive education in 3 subjects: technology (mathematics-physics), economy (mathematics-English) and natural (chemistry-biology). Students are admitted to the school from the 7th grade. Admission processes are based on the principles of fairness and transparency. The candidate will take the exam twice. A student who successfully passes the first stage prepares for the second test. Both processes take place with the participation of students' parents or relatives, and the grades obtained by applicants are announced on the same day. This, of course, allows to select young people who are talented, intelligent, and hungry for knowledge. Most importantly, bribery, nepotism and other factors that negatively affect the education system are not allowed in the admission process. In the future, it is planned to establish a higher education institution in this place and train personnel in a modern cluster method.

Today, September 3, the new building of the international school was commissioned. Officials of regional and district administrations, heads of public education departments of cities and districts, labor veterans, the general public, activists and young people took part in the solemn event.

Speaking at the event, the governor of the region, Botir Zaripov, emphasized that under the leadership of the head of state, great attention is being paid to educational processes in our country, and all conditions and facilities are being created for the young generation to acquire modern knowledge. It was recognized that this building was a wonderful gift to the people of Bukhara on the 30th anniversary of our country's independence, and on the Day of Knowledge, which is welcomed with great excitement. Confidence was expressed that in the new building, students will get a decent education, conquer high peaks, and raise the honor and glory of our country, our beloved Bukhara, to even higher heights.

Also, labor veteran R. Niyazov, deputy head of the neighborhood and family support department, S. Husenov, chairman of the "Nuroniy" board, A. Husenova, member of the Senate of the Oliy Majlis, and S. Ostonova, winner of the state award named after Zulfia, spoke at the ceremony. During the event, special respect was paid to the creators of the educational facility.

After that, Bukhara students, their teachers and school principals, who won prizes in the national and international science Olympiads held this year, were duly awarded. The ribbon was cut, and the symbolic key was solemnly handed over to the school administration.

Those gathered got acquainted with the conditions created in the international school of mathematics. In conclusion, it can be said that Karakol tried to create an opportunity out of every problem. Educate the gifted and there will be no need to punish the adults, the slogan was followed.
